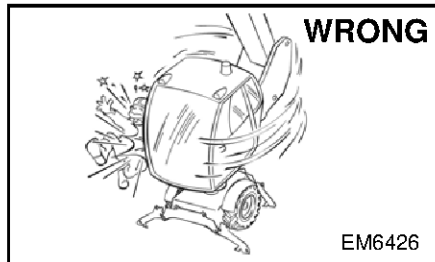
Never operate without instructions. See machine signs (decals), and Operation & Maintenance Manual.



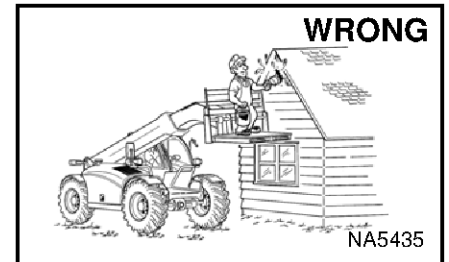
Safety Alert Symbol: This symbol with a warning statement, means: "Warning, be alert! Your safety is involved!" Carefully read the message that follows.



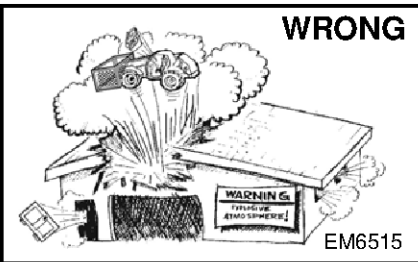
Always fasten seat belt snugly. Always keep your feet and arms inside the cab.



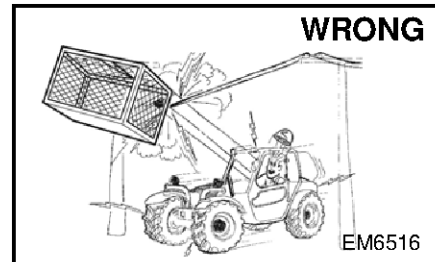
Never swing the upperstructure when someone is near the telescopic handler.



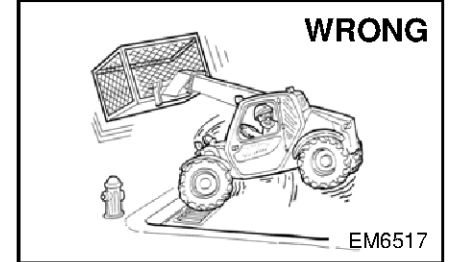
Never carry riders. Use only an approved work platform.



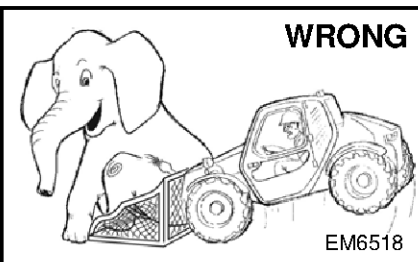
Do not use machine in atmosphere with explosive dust, explosive gas, or where exhaust can contact flammable material.



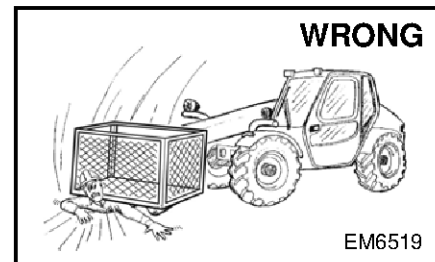
Check for overhead or underground power lines before operating. Keep boom, attachment, and load a minimum of 3 m (10 ft) away from electrical power lines.



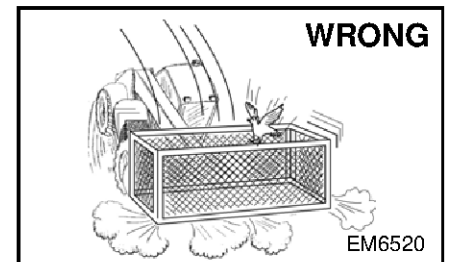
Always carry buckets or attachments as low as possible. Do not travel or turn with boom up. Load, unload, and turn on flat level ground.



Never exceed Rated Load Capacity. Read and understand the Load Capacity Charts.



Never exit the machine with engine running or with boom raised. To park, put transmission in neutral, engage parking brake, and put attachment flat on the ground.



Never modify equipment. Use only attachments approved by Bobcat Company for this model telescopic handler.

SAFETY EQUIPMENT

The Bobcat telescopic handler must be equipped with safety items necessary for each job. Ask your dealer for information on the safe use of attachments and accessories.

1. SEAT BELT: Check belt fasteners and check for damaged webbing or buckle.
2. OPERATOR CAB: It must be on the telescopic handler with all fasteners tight. Never operate without right window.
3. SAFETY SIGNS (DECALS): Replace if damaged.
4. SAFETY TREADS: Replace if damaged.
5. GRAB HANDLES: Replace if damaged.
6. BOOM STOP: Replace if damaged.
7. PARKING BRAKE: Check for function.
8. WINDOWS AND MIRRORS: Clean and check for broken glass or mirrors. Replace if damaged.
