
Always fasten seat belt snugly. Always keep your feet and inside the cab.










Do not use machine in atmosphere with explosive dust, explosive gas, or where exhaust can contact flammable material.



Check for overhead underground power lines before operating.






Always carry buckers attachments as low as possible.



To park, put transmission in neutral. engage parking brake, and put attachment flat on the ground.



The Bobcat telescopic handler must be equipped with safety items necessary for each job. Ask your dealer for information on the safe use of attachments and accessories.

- SEAT BELT: Check belt fasteners and check for damaged webbing or buckle.
- OPERATOR CAB: It must be on the telescopic handler with all fasteners tight. Never operate without right window.
- SAFETY SIGNS (DECALS): Replace if damaged. SAFETY TREADS: Replace if damaged. GRAB HANDLES: Replace if damaged.

- BOOM STOP: Replace if damaged.
 PARKING BRAKE: Check for function.
 WINDOWS AND MIRRORS: Clean and check for broken glass or mirrors. Replace if damaged.
