I. SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

A. SAFETY IS THE OPERATOR'S RESPONSIBILITY

The Bobcat loader and Three-Point Hitch are designed to give maximum safety; but no machine design can prevent operator error or carelessness.

B. READ THIS MANUAL BEFORE YOU OPERATE THE BOBCAT LOADER AND THREE-POINT HITCH

II. SAFE OPERATION NEEDS A QUALIFIED OPERATOR

A QUALIFIED OPERATOR* MUST DO THE FOLLOWING:

A. UNDERSTAND THE WRITTEN INSTRUCTIONS, RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. The written instructions from Melroe Company include the delivery report, operator's handbook and operation & maintenance manual, the attachment manual and machine signs (decals).
- 2. Check the rules and regulations at your location. The rules may include an employer's work safety requirements.

B. HAVE TRAINING WITH ACTUAL OPERATION

- 1. Operator training must consist of a demonstration and verbal instruction. This training is given by the Bobcat loader dealer before the machine is delivered.
- 2. The new operator must start in an area without bystanders and use all the controls until he can operate safely under all conditions of his work area.

C. KNOW THE WORK CONDITIONS

- The operator must know any prohibited uses or work areas for the machine. For example, he needs to know what slopes
 are excessive.
- * For an operator to be qualified, he must not use drugs or alcoholic drinks which impair his alertness or coordination while working. An operator who is taking prescription drugs must get medical advice on whether or not he can safely operate a machine.
