
Always install approved lift arm support device when servicing rotary cutter. Raise lift arms and tilt Bob-Tach fully forward.




Always use the seat bar and fasten seat belt snugly. Always keep feet on the pedals when operating loader.




Always check work area before operating rotary cutter. Never use loader without operator cab with ROPS and FOPS approval. Fasten your seat




Do not use loader or rotary cutter in atmosphere with explosive dust, gas, or where exhaust can contact flammable material.








Keep bystanders away when operating rotary cutter. Do not operate without blade shut-off device.
