

## MAINTENANCE SAFETY





Safety Alert Symbol: This symbol with a warning statement, means: "Warning, be alert! Your safety is involved!" Carefully read the message that follows.




Never service the B obcat Loader Backhoe without instructions.



Always use an approved lift arm support device when servicing the loader backhoe with the lift arms raised. Replace the lift arm support device if damaged or missing.

Disconnecting or loosening any hydraulic tubeline, hose, fitting component, or p art failure can cause lift arms or backhoe boom to drop.





Wear dust mask when grinding painted parts. Toxic dust and gas can be produced.




Vent exhaust to o utside when engine must be run for service. Exhaust system must be tightly sealed. Ex haust Fumes can kill without warning.



Never work on loader backhoe with lift arms raised unless supported by an approved lift arm support device.

Always lower the b ackhoe bucket to the ground before Always doing any maintenance.




Stop, cool and clean engine of flammable materials before checking fluids.

Never service or adjust machine with the engine running unless instructed to do so in the manual.

Avoid contact with leaking hydraulic fluid or diesel fuel Avoid under pressure. It can penetrate the skin or eyes.

Never fill fuel tank with engine running, while smoking or when near open flame.



Keep body, jewelry and clothing away from moving parts, electrical contact, hot parts and exhaust.

Wear eye protection to guard from battery acid, compressed springs, fluids under pressure and flying debris when engines are running or tools are used. Use eye protection approved for

type of welding.

WRONG B-6589 Lead-acid batteries

produce flammable and explosive gases.

Keep arcs, sparks, flames and lighted tobacco away from batteries.

Batteries contain acid which burns eyes or skin on con tact. Wear protective clothing. If a cid contacts body, flush well with water. For eye contact flush well and get attention. immediate medical

Keep engine cover closed except for service. Close and latch engine cover before operating the loader backhoe.

Maintenance procedures which are given in the Operation & Maintenance Manual can be performed by the owner/ operator without any specific technical training. Maintenance procedures which are not in the Ope ration & Maintenance Manual must be performed ONLY BY QUALIFIED BOBCAT SERVICE PERSONNEL. Always use genuine Bobcat replacement parts.
