
MAINTENANCE SAFETY



Instructions are necessary before operating or servicing machine. Read and understand the Operation & Maintenance Manual, Operator's Handbook and signs (decals) on machine. Follow warnings and instructions in the manuals when making repairs, adjustments or servicing. Check for correct function after adjustments, repairs or service. Untrained operators and failure to follow instructions can cause injury or death. W-2003-0807


Never service the Bobcat Excavator without instructions.




ventilation good welding or grinding painted parts.
Wear dust mask when grinding

Vent exhaust to outside when engine must be run for service. Exhaust system must be tightly sealed. Exhaust fumes can kill without warning.

Always lower the bucket and blade to the ground before doing any maintenance. Never modify equipment or add attachments not approved by Bobcat Company.

Keep body, jewelry and clothing away from moving parts, electrical contact, hot parts and exhaust.


B-19798 Lead-acid batteries produce flammable and explosive gases.

Wear eye protection to guard from battery acid, compressed springs, fluids under pressure and flying debris when engines are running or tools are used. Use eye protections approved for type of

Keep arcs, sparks, flames and lighted tobacco away batteries.

welding. Keep tailgate closed except for service. Close and latch tailgate before operating the excavator. Batteries contain acid which burns eyes or skin on contact.

Wear protective clothing. If acid contacts body, flush well with water. For eye contact flush well and get immediate medical and get attention.



Never service or adjust machine with the engine running unless instructed to do so in the manual.

Avold contact with leaking hydraulic fluid or diesel fuel under pressure. It can penetrate

the skin or eyes.

Never fill fuel tank with engine running, while smoking, or when near open flame.

Maintenance procedures which are given in the Operation & Maintenance Manual can be performed by the owner/operator without any specific technical training. Maintenance procedures which are not in the Operation & Maintenance Manual must be performed ONLY BY QUALIFIED BOBCAT SERVICE PERSONNEL. Always use genuine Bobcat replacement parts. The Service Safety Training Course is available from your Bobcat dealer.
