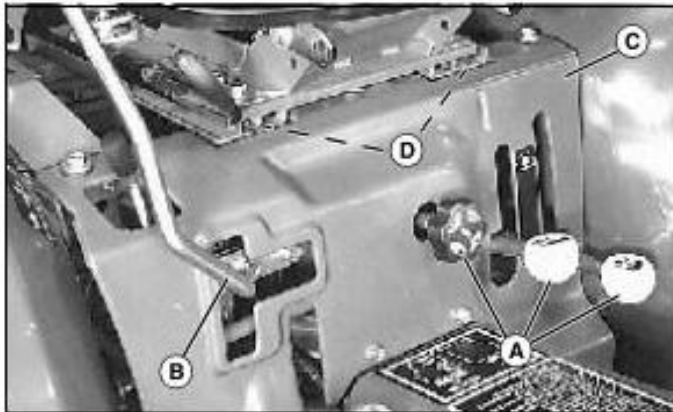

Repair

Seat Removal and Installation

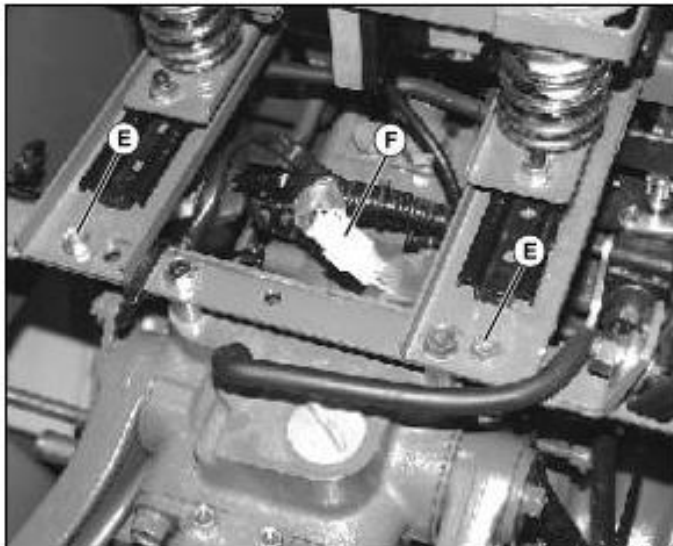

1. Remove knobs (A).
2. Remove SCV lever (B), if equipped.

NOTE: Move seat forward to remove top capscrew from front panel.

3. Remove front panel (C).
4. Remove nuts (D).

5. Slide seat forward and tilt up.
6. Remove capscrews, washers and nuts (E).
7. Disconnect wiring harness (F).
8. Remove seat and support.
9. Install seat and support.
10. Connect wiring harness.
11. Install front panel, knobs and SCV lever, if equipped.

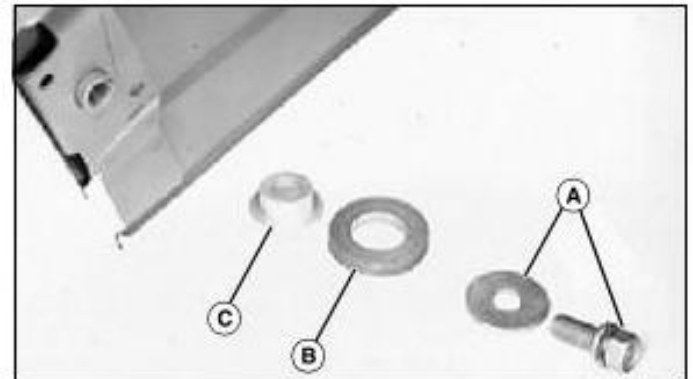
Hood Removal and Installation

1. Remove dash cover.

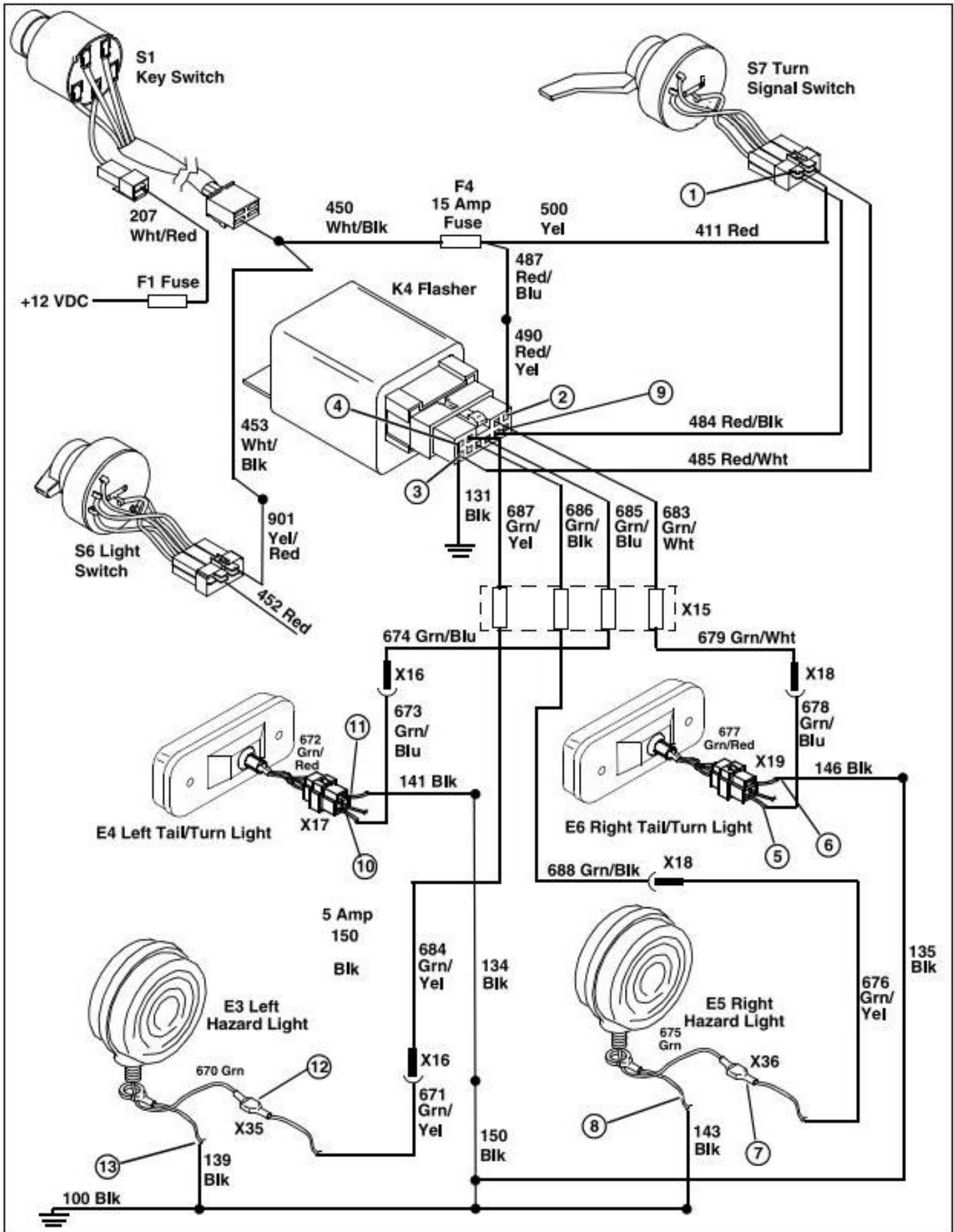
2. Remove capscrew and washer (A).

3. Remove cushion (B) and bushing (C) from each side.
4. Remove hood.
5. Inspect support cushions (B) for excessive wear or damage. Replace if necessary.
6. Install hood and dash cover.
7. Check and adjust hood latch clearance. See "Hood Latch Clearance Adjustment" on page 337.
